Note from the Principal

From October 2nd-12th, GMS will be hosting 16 students and two chaperones from Spain! This is the first time we have done an exchange program swap like this, and we are so excited. Sixteen of our high school students and their families will host these visitors, and then those same 16 students will spend Spring Break 2025 in Seville, Spain living life with them in the city.

Whose idea was this, you ask? Del Swartzentruber is the ring-leader and brains behind it all! He and his

family lived in Seville for the 2021-2022 school year where he taught in the same

school that we will be partnering with.



The goal of the exchange is to experience the richness of another culture - from the foods to the homes to the surrounding sites and activities. While the Spanish students are in Delaware, they will attend GMS classes, learn about harness racing, tour an organic chicken farm, learn about the role of Fort Miles in the World Wars and discover Harriet Tubman's impact in the Underground Railroad. We will take day trips to Washington, D.C. to tour the White House, visit monuments and take in a Washington Capitals hockey game. A few days later, we will visit Philly to tour the Art Museum, Liberty Bell, U.S. Mint, etc. Other local events will include GMS sports games, a Milford Football game, and Apple Scrapple! It is going to be a very busy 12 days!

In order to earn some academic credit for days missed, each student will choose aspects of the trip/history to research and become an expert in. They will write a paper, create a presentation, and report to the group on all they have learned. They will also write reflection essays after hosting our guests and then again after visiting Spain.

Our time in Spain will simply be the mirror side of the program. We will stay in host homes, visit their school, and take in all manner of cultural items related to Spain. Our students have been active on DuoLingo to brush up on conversational Spanish and vocabulary to prepare for being immersed in a Spanish-speaking city.

Please pray for safety over these days as there will be much travel and interaction. Pray that the students can quickly make friendships with one another and that we can be a good example of what it means to live for Jesus in our daily setting.
